

LIST OF INSURED OCCUPATIONAL DISEASES IN VIETNAM

I. The list of occupational diseases by Joint Circular No 08/1998/TTLT-BYT-BLDTBXH dated May 19th, 1976 providing guidance on the implementation of the provisions on occupational diseases.

1. The disease caused by infection with silicosis (SiO₂)
2. Asbestosis caused by dust asbestos
3. Intoxication Lead and lead compounds
4. Intoxication substances benzene and benzene homologues
5. Intoxication of mercury and mercury compounds
6. Intoxication manganese and manganese compounds
7. Diseases caused by X -rays and radioactive substances
8. Deafness due to noise

II. The list of occupational diseases by Inter-ministries circular No 29/TT-LB dated December 25th, 1991 on the addition of occupational diseases

1. Skin ulcers, nasal septum ulcers, dermatitis, and eczema contact
2. Tattoo skin disease
3. Occupational vibration disease
4. Asbestosis cotton
5. Occupational tuberculosis
6. Viral hepatitis carrier
7. Occupational leptospirosis
8. Intoxication TNT (Trinitrotoluene)

III. The list of occupational diseases by Decision No 167/BYT-QD dated January 4th, 1997 on modifying 5 occupational diseases into the list of occupational diseases to be insured.

1. Intoxication of arsenic and arsenic compounds carrier
2. Nicotine Intoxication carrier
3. Intoxication of occupational pesticide chemicals
4. Professional pressure disease

5. Chronic bronchitis career

IV. The list of occupational diseases by Decision No 27/2006/QĐ-BYT dated September 21st, 2006 on modifying 4 occupational diseases into the list of occupational diseases to be insured.

1. Occupational bronchial asthma
2. Occupational carbon monoxide contaminated disease
3. Occupational oil acne disease
4. Occupational ulcerative skin disease, occupational inflammation around the nails and occupational nail inflammation disease

V. The list of occupational diseases by Circular No 42/2011/TT-BYT November 30th, 2011 on the addition of occupational diseases resulting from cadmium poisoning, whole-body vibration, and occupational HIV infection to the list of insured occupational diseases; guidance on standardized diagnosis and examination.

1. Cadmium Intoxication career
2. Occupational diseases caused by whole body vibration
3. HIV infection due to occupational accidents

V. The list of occupational diseases by Circular No 44/2013/TT-BYT dated December 24th, 2013 on the addition of occupational diseases resulting from Talc pneumoconiosis to the list of insured occupational diseases; guidance on standardized diagnosis and examination.
